I'm hoping to inspire positive change in my community, while also learning and collaborating with my fellow Council members.

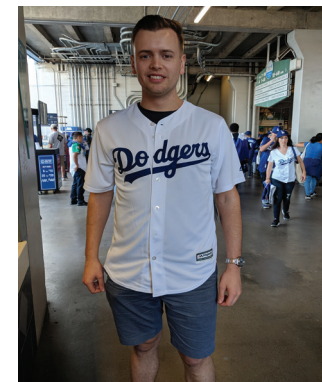
What accomplishment are you most proud of to date?
