leadership skills.

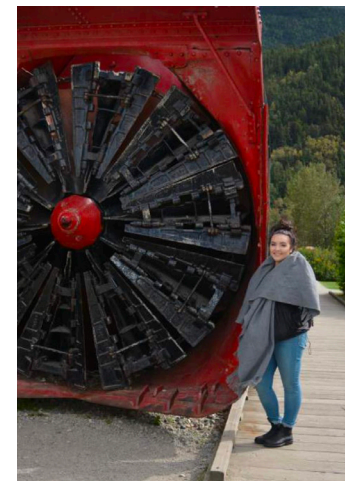
Bio
